Session 3, Learning Activity 1, "The Wall: Security or Apartheid", p. 143:

"Walls That Divide Are Broken Down"

Sing the following to the tune of "Tallis Canon":

God's promises to us are sure,
Dividing walls cannot endure
When we with others take a stand
To work to break them, hand in hand.

Session 4, Learning Activity 1, "Jesus Is Laid in the Tomb", p. 147; 201:

For "Waa Habibi, "Waa Habibi" substitute one of the following:

"Ayyuhal masslubu zulman (So Much Wrong)". *Global Praise 3*, pp. 157-158. This Palestinian hymn by Jubrail Gabbour includes both the Arabic and the English lyrics.

"Yarabba ssalami (You God of peace)". *Global Praise 3*, p. 175. A traditional Palestinian melody with lyrics in both Arabic and English by an unknown author.

Session 4, Learning Activity 5, Closing Worship", pp. 148-151:

"Christ, Our Peace". The worship includes the lyrics for this chant, but not the melodic line. Use a traditional chant melody, or simply speak the words in unison.
