Protect the Right to Vote

Voting rights are key to a democratic society. As we face what many have called the most important election in a generation, significant challenges to the electoral process pose barriers to civic engagement. The voter integrity group Verified Voting has reported instances of technological failures, and vote tabulation discrepancies have already been found when testing voting machines in Florida and West Virginia. According to Verified Voting, some voting machines may not have a voter verified paper trail audit. Long lines are expected on Election Day, potentially resulting in uncast ballots and voter disenfranchisement.
