

IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER DEADLINE LOOMING

Are you 70 1/2 years of age or older? If so - you can make a direct transfer from both Traditional or Roth IRAs of up to \$100,000 to the Women's Division - but you need to act now! The current Pension Protection Act is set to expire on December 31, 2009. (Congress could take action to extend the provision for another year but that is far from certain.)

Such a gift to the Women's Division is a creative way to support the Division's world-wide ministries with women, children and youth in over 130 countries.

Making a direct transfer now to a charitable organization such as the Women's Division may reduce the amount of taxable withdrawals in future years. And because of the reduction in the IRA's value may also lower tax burdens on your heirs. The process is simple; your broker can handle all of the details. All that the broker needs is the Women's Division address and Tax ID number:
